



Coronavirus (COVID-19)

We know many of you have questions about COVID-19 and your health plan coverage through Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Minnesota (Blue Cross).

COVID-19 Services Coverage

When medically necessary and appropriate, which is currently determined by accepted guidelines from the Center for Disease Control and/or the Minnesota Department of Health, a screening test ordered by a medical professional will be covered at no cost with no prior authorization required.

No cost for Doctor on Demand Telemedicine Services

Effective March 14, there will be a \$0 copay for [Doctor on Demand](#) telemedicine services for the next 30 days.

- When you purchase prescriptions at Boynton you simply pay your standard copay, so if Boynton is conveniently located for you you may find it continues to be your best option.
- If Boynton is not conveniently located for you, we have temporarily modified the reimbursement policy for covered prescriptions purchased outside Boynton. From now through April 1 you are able to receive full reimbursement less the standard prescription copay for prescriptions filled at any non-Boynton pharmacy. This reimbursement policy only applies for medications on the [SHBP formulary](#). *For example, if your covered prescription costs \$90 at a non-Boynton pharmacy you would pay the full cost of \$90 for the prescription at the time of pickup but then you may submit a reimbursement request to the Office of Student Health Benefits in which you will be refunded the full cost minus your prescription copay.*

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
