



Information about the 2021-2022 Graduate Assistant Health Plan (GAHP), administered by the Office of Student Health Benefits, is now available.

Open Enrollment Information

Open enrollment information and forms can be found on our [website](#). This year, printed packets are not available for our office to send to you.

Eligibility & Coverage

Students meeting certain [conditions](#) are eligible to participate in the Graduate Assistant Health Plan (GAHP). Students must be in an eligible position and properly registered for the number of credits required for their job class or appointment. Those who meet these criteria will need to submit a [21-22 GAHP Enrollment and Change Form](#) to our office to elect GAHP benefits.

Coverage for the 2021-2022 academic year will begin or continue based on our office's verification that the student has a [qualifying](#) assistantship or fellowship. Enrollment will be processed by our office after active and eligible job data can be verified in HRMS.

Departments who offer a qualifying fellowship or traineeship (9560, 9561, 9562, 9564, 9565 or 9566) must submit a [Department Authorization Form \(pdf\)](#) for the fellow/trainee to be eligible for the GAHP.

Enrollment Reminders

- *All **new** graduate assistants, fellows, and trainees* must submit an enrollment form to receive GAHP benefits. Completing the online Health Coverage Declaration does not enroll students in the GAHP.
- *Current GAHP members with enrolled dependents* must re-enroll their dependents at the start of the academic year. Dependents must be re-enrolled each Fall semester for their coverage to continue.
- *Current primary GAHP members* do not have to take any action. As long as they remain an eligible graduate assistant, fellow, or trainee, their enrollment in the GAHP will automatically continue.
