The University has negotiated benefits, including student loan payoff and a tax-free monthly disability payment, that are not available outside of the University. The Long-Term Disability Insurance Plan also provides an opportunity to convert to an individual policy to take with you after you leave the University. This option, the Guaranteed Standard Issue Conversion Option, is available with no medical underwriting. This means you won't have exclusions or be turned down for coverage because of your medical history.
