Our office is unable to verify your fall 2022 eligibility for enrollment in the Graduate Assistant Health Plan (GAHP). **Your coverage will terminate as of August 31, 2022.** You may request a formal termination letter from Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Minnesota via postal mail within 5 business days.

To be eligible for the GAHP, you must hold a qualifying assistantship or fellowship through the graduate school at 25% or greater and you must be registered for the minimum required credits for an assistantship. Detailed eligibility criteria can be found on our <u>website</u>.

If you have a qualifying graduate assistantship or fellowship and feel that you received this message in error, please contact the Office of Student Health Benefits immediately.

If you were enrolled in the GAHP last semester and are no longer eligible for the plan, you may purchase the Continuation of Coverage plan at your own expense (including coverage for dependents that were previously covered under your GAHP). To enroll in the Continuation of Coverage, submit an enrollment form no later than October 31, 2022. Visit our website for more information.

Current University of Minnesota Students: If eligible* you will be enrolled in the University-sponsored <u>Student Health Benefit Plan</u>. A charge for the plan will be posted to your student account and you will receive a new card from Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Minnesota. If you have other health insurance coverage, please notify us by September 29, 2022.
