

Dear residents and fellows,

Open enrollment for the University-sponsored Residents, Fellows, and Interns (RFI) benefits began May 1st and continues through June 15, 2023, or within 30 days of your start date, whichever is later.

All residents, fellows, and interns must either enroll in the RFI medical plan or waive coverage by providing documentation of other comparable health insurance coverage.

If you choose to enroll in an RFI benefit plan, benefits will be effective as of your start date. Flexible Spending Accounts (FSAs), which are elected via \underline{MyU} , will start the first day of the month following your start date. If you choose to waive RFI benefits, you are required to submit a <u>Health Insurance Waiver Request form</u> (pdf) and documentation of other comparable health insurance coverage by the applicable deadline.
