



### Prescription Benefit

[Boynton Pharmacy](#), the preferred pharmacy for the Student Health Benefit Plan (SHBP), likely remains your best and most convenient option for filling your prescriptions when near campus. With Boynton Pharmacy, you can order a **90-day supply** of your medication which may be beneficial before leaving campus for winter break. Call 612-624-7655 to refill your Boynton Pharmacy prescription or fill out their [transfer form](#) if your prescription was last filled at another pharmacy. Boynton Pharmacy is open on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 7:45 am to 4:30 pm, and Thursdays from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm. [Learn more](#).

### Student Dental Buy-Up Plan

If you would like restorative dental benefits (for services such as fillings and tooth removal), you can enroll in the optional Dental Buy-Up Plan (SDP) for an additional fee. The start date for restorative dental benefits is February 1 and continues through August 31, 2024. To enroll, fill out the [online enrollment form](#) or submit an [enrollment form](#) (PDF) to the Office of Student Health benefits by **February 8**. Students who were eligible in the fall semester and are joining the Dental Buy-Up Plan for the spring semester will be billed \$984.48. Students who are newly eligible for the spring semester will be billed \$492.24. [Learn more](#).
